1. During KMS 2011-12, the Andhra Pradesh State Civil Supplies Corporation Ltd, has purchased 6.04 crores of new B.Twill gunnies of 50 Kg capacity from the DGS & D for utilization in paddy purchases.

2. As per the Government orders, 50% of these gunnies would be utilized for delivery of CMR and balance 50% will be left over with the CSC. The Government of India have allowed 40% gunny depreciation on left over gunnies after delivery of CMR i.e., new gunnies once used for paddy filling.

3. Therefore, the Government of India was requested by the CCS & EOS vide reference 4<sup>th</sup> cited to accord permission for utilizing the new gunnies once used for paddy in KMS 2011-12 and left over after delivery of CMR for procurement of paddy in KMS 2012-13.

4. The Government of India vide reference 5<sup>th</sup> cited have accorded permission for utilization of once used gunnies after delivery of custom milled rice of 2011-12 for purchase of paddy during KMS 2012-13 in 50:50 ratio. The old gunny bags used for procurement of

paddy should conform to the specifications laid down i.e., "Gunnies in question should be free from any mildew/fungal growth, cuts, holes or tears, sunfading, etc., grains should not bleed out of the bags and the seams should be intact. Bags should be intact and not be repaired ones. The weight of the 50 Kg bags should not be less than 500 grms". A copy of the orders received from Government of India is sent here with for ready reference.

5. Therefore, the District Managers are requested to take back the left over new gunnies once used for paddy after delivery of CMR from the rice millers, as already informed vide ref.2<sup>nd</sup> cited.

6. If any miller wants to retain the bags, the miller may be allowed and the cost there of should be collected at 60% of purchase cost as already requested vide reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited.

7. District Managers are requested to take the following precautions at the time of receiving the gunnies from the millers.

- Gunnies should be in good condition as per the specifications of the GOI as mentioned at para '5'.
- Gunnies shall be checked and counted thoroughly at the time of acceptance.
- Acknowledgements shall be given only for sound gunnies conforming to the specifications.
- Millers shall be requested to return the new gunnies sent with paddy by the Corporation and leftover after delivery of CMR only. No other gunnies shall be accepted.
- Millers shall hand over the gunnies at our godown point at his cost.
- These gunnies shall be utilized for paddy procurement in KMS 2011-12 in 50:50 ratio as ordered by the GOI.
- CMR shall be delivered in new gunny bags in which paddy has been purchased for KMS 2012-13.
- Separate Accounts shall be maintained for these gunnies.

- Gunnies shall be kept in scientific godown and necessary preservative measures be taken as per the instructions issued vide Circular No.88/Mktg, dated: 20.06.2011.

The details of new gunnies utilized for paddy in KMS 2011-12 and left over after delivery of CMR shall be informed immediately so as to enable Head Office to arrive at the correct requirement of new gunnies for KMS 2012-13 and also to furnish information to the GOI.

The receipt of this Circular should be acknowledged by return of post.

Subject: Permission to use once-used gunny bags for procurement of paddy after the delivery of paddy/Custom milled rice of previous years for KMS 2012-13.

Sir,


I am directed to refer to your letter CCS Ref. No.P(1)/2635/2012 dated 21.08.2012 and to state the following:-

- (i) As proposed by Government of Andhra Pradesh once-used bags left over from KMS 2011-12 can be used for purchase of paddy during KMS 2012-13 in 50:50 ratio. The old bags used for procurement of paddy should conform to the specifications laid down vide this Department's letter of even number dated 15.2.2006. The specifications laid down are reiterated as under:-  
*"Gunnies in question should be free from any mildew/fungal growth, cuts, holes or tears, sunfading, etc; grains should not bleed out of the bags and the seams should be intact. Bags should be intact and not be repaired ones. The weight of the 50 kg bags should not be less than 500 gms."*
- (ii) The responsibility to ensure that the once used bags used for procurement of paddy conform to the specifications laid down by Government of India will be that of the State Government. Any loss due to damage to paddy/resultant rice due to storage of paddy in once used gunny bags will be borne by the State Government. In no case specification of rice to be delivered by millers will be relaxed if the quality of rice is found to be below specifications due to use of once used gunny bags.
- (iii) Delivery of milled rice would be permitted only in new gunny bags of KMS 2012-13 in which paddy has been procured. The bags in which rice is accepted should bear the marking of the relevant marketing season i.e. KMS 2012-13.

2. State Government will maintain separate accounts keeping therein details of number of such once used gunny bags used, their source and their book value etc. Such accounts are to be audited as per extant procedure.
