In the reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited, the Government of Andhra Pradesh issued orders for purchase of damaged paddy under relaxed specifications in the rain effected districts of Srikakulam, Visakhapatnam, East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Guntur, Frakasam, Nellore and Khammam. It was also ordered that the paddy purchased under URS specifications shall be stacked separately at scientific godowns so as to take appropriate decision at the time of disposal of paddy stocks. Accordingly, detailed guidelines were ammunicated vide reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited to the concerned District dianagers for purchase of paddy under URS specifications as per the Government Order.

The Government vide the reference 4<sup>th</sup> cited (copy enclosed) assued the following orders fixing out turn ratio for resultant rice from out of damaged paddy purchased:

- The paddy purchased by the APSCSCL with relaxed specifications has to be custom milled and the resultant rice to be delivered to the FCI or APSCSCL based on the FAQ specifications – boiled rice to the FCI and the raw rice to be retained by the APSCSCL for PDS requirements.
- ❖ The Collectors (CS) of the districts where the damaged, discoloured, sprouted and Weevilled paddy is being purchased by the APSCSCL shall ensure that the paddy is handed over to the rice mills immediately for custom milling and delivery of resultant rice to the FCI/APSCSCL as the case may be.
- ❖ Since the damaged paddy which is purchased with relaxation does not yield the normal out turn of 67% for raw rice, the percentage of out turn of raw rice to be delivered by the rice millers against the damaged, discoloured, sprouted and weevilled paddy procured with value cut is fixed as indicated in the annexure.
- For every percentage in excess of 4% FAQ specification under damaged, discoloured, sprouted and weevilled grains, the out turn percentage is indicated in the annexure.
- The rice millers shall be entitled for the milling charges etc., for milling this paddy as is applicable for FAQ paddy milling under custom milling.
- ❖ The Collectors (CS) shall ensure that the paddy is transported to the mills immediately after procurement without having any intermediate storage and that the resultant rice of FAQ specifications is delivered to the FCI under CMR if it is boiled rice and to the APSCSCL if it is raw rice, at the CMR rates fixed.

Therefore, the JC & EOED, APSCSCL, is requested to take immediate action as per the above orders and ensure that paddy is transported to designated rice mills, taking into consideration of the distance from the PPC. There shall not be any intermediate storage of URS paddy. The rice millers shall be directed to undertake the custom milling of URS paddy immediately, to avoid further deterioration of quality and deliver the resultant rice of FAQ specifications to the FCI under CMR if it is boiled rice and to the APSCSCL if it is raw rice at the out turn ratio fixed by the Government.

The out turn ratio of boiled rice to be delivered to FCI as per the FAQ specifications for the paddy purchased under URS specifications is not fixed by the Government. The CCS & EOS., is requested to communicate the percentage of out turn of boiled rice to be delivered by the rice miller under CMR against every percent over and above 4% (per quintal). The same will be communicated after receipt of orders fixing the out turn ratio for boiled rice.

The receipt of this Circular shall be acknowledged by return of post.

Sub: Civil Supplies – KMS 2012-2013 - Purchase of Damaged, Discoloured, Sprouted and Weevilled Paddy by the APSCSCL – Custom milling of paddy purchased under relaxed specifications – Percentage of out turn of rice - Regarding.

Ref: G.O.Ms.No.53 Consumer Affairs, Food and Civil Supplies (CS.I) Department dated 13.12.2012.

In the G.O. cited, the Government have issued orders for purchase of damaged paddy in the districts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Guntur, Prakasam, Nellore and Khammam with relaxed specifications of damaged, discoloured, sprouted and weevilled grains upto 10% without value cut and from 11% to 50% with value cut by the A.P.State Civil Supplies Corporation Ltd.

- 2. Orders of the Govt. of India on relaxations sought for purchase of damaged paddy and delivery of rice under CMR and Mill levy are yet to be received from the Govt. of India. Pending receipt of relaxations from the Govt. of India, the G.O. cited was issued for purchase of damaged paddy by the APSCSCL. Since the damaged paddy is being purchased by the APSCSCL, it is necessary to issue orders fixing out turn ratio for resultant rice from out of damaged paddy purchased. The following orders are therefore issued which are similar to those issued in 2010-11 KMS.
- 3. The paddy purchased by the A.P. State Civil Supplies Corporation Ltd with relaxed specifications has to be custom milled and the resultant rice to be delivered to the FCI or APSCSCL based on the FAQ specifications boiled rice to the FCI and the raw rice to be retained by the APSCSCL for PDS requirements.
- 4. The Collectors (CS) of the districts where the damaged, discoloured, sprouted and Weevilled paddy is being purchased by the APSCSCL shall ensure that this paddy is handed over to the rice mills immediately for custom milling and delivery of resultant rice to the FCI / APSCSCL as the case may be.
- 5. Since the damaged paddy which is purchased with relaxations does not yield the normal out turn of 67% for raw rice, the percentage of out turn of raw rice to be delivered by the rice millers against the damaged, discoloured, sprouted and weevilled paddy procured with value cut is fixed as indicated in the annexure. It is further clarified that:
- if the paddy is having damaged, discoloured, sprouted and weevilled grains up to 4%, which is the FAQ specification, the out turn shall be 67% of raw rice.
- if the paddy is having damaged, discoloured, sprouted and weevilled arains up to 10%, which is 6% over the FAQ specification, the out turn shall be 62.98% of raw rice. (i.e. 67\*94/100).
- if the paddy is having damaged, discoloured, sprouted and weevilled grains up to 20%, which is 16% over of the FAQ specification, the out turn shall be 56.28% raw rice. (i.e. 67\*84/100).
- in the paddy is having damaged, discoloured, sprouted and weevilled grains up to 30%, which is 16% over the FNO specification, the out turn thail be 49.58% or raw tice to 16.71 1/100).

- or the paddy is having damaged, discoloured, sprouted and weevilled grains upto 40%, which is 36% over the FAQ specification, the out turn snall be 42.88% of raw rice (i.e. 67\*64/100).
- if the paddy is having damaged, discoloured, sprouted and weevilled grains upto 50%, which is 46% over the FAQ specification, the out turn shall be 36.18% of raw rice (i.e. 67\*54/100).
- 6. Accordingly, for every percentage in excess of 4% FAQ specification under damaged, discoloured, sprouted and weevilled grains, the out turn percentage is indicated in the annexure.
- 7. The rice millers shall be entitled for the milling charges etc. for milling this paddy as is applicable for FAQ paddy milling under custom milling.
- 8. The Collectors (CS) shall ensure that the paddy is transported to the mills immediately after procurement without having any intermediate storage and that the resultant rice of FAQ specifications is delivered to the FCI under CMR if it is boiled rice and to the AP State Civil Supplies Corporation if it is raw rice, at the CMR rates fixed.
- 9. The Collectors (CS) shall take necessary action in the matter immediately. The VC & MD, AP State Civil Supplies Corporation Ltd. shall coordinate with the Collectors (CS) concerned and ensure that the custom milling is done immediately.
