The Government of India vide the references cited have communicated the final rates of CMR delivered by the Govt. of A.P., and its Agencies to the Central Pool by the State Government for the KMS 2000-01 to 2005-06. The Commissioner of Civil Supplies & EOS, Govt. of A.P., have also directed to submit the final claims to the FCI for payment of the difference amounts.

The GOI have not considered the actual expenditure incurred by the Corporation while finalizing the final rates of CMR delivered to the Central Pool. Therefore, the GOI was requested to reconsider the matter and orders are awaited. The matter has been perceived with the GOI.

In view of the above it has been decided to prefer claims as per the final rates of CMR approved by the GOI subject to revision of the same after receipt of the orders from the GOI.

The GOI approved rates for the KMS 2000-01 to 2005-06 are sent herewith in Annexure I to VI.

The District Managers, CSC, are requested to prepare KMS wise and season wise (Khariff and Rabi) separate claims for these six (6) crop years and submit the same to the respective Area Managers, FCI and obtain payment of the difference amounts.

In addition to the above final rates of CMR differential Sales Tax i.e. the Sales Tax payable as per the final rates of CMR and Purchase Tax of 4% on paddy allowed by the FCI earlier, is also to be claimed along with the final rates of CMR.

The KMS wise differential Sales Tax to be claimed is detailed in the Annexure – VII. The KMS wise / Variety wise, Boiled and Raw rice delivered to FCI as per the final accounts furnished by the District Offices are communicated in the Annexure – VIII for ready reference.

The FCI earlier released the Custody & Maintenance charges, Interest, Gunny Depreciation, Statutory charges i.e. RD Cess and Market Fee as per the Provisional Cost sheet and later recovered those amounts in subsequent bills due to some audit paras and other administrative orders of the FCI. Hence, only the net amount released by the FCI as on date shall be deducted from the amount payable as per the final rates of CMR. Hence, the District Managers, CSC, shall prepare the claims with utmost care, duly taking into consideration of the net amounts received from FCI.

The progress of the claims preferred on Area Managers, FCI, and realization of amounts shall be informed to Head Office on weekly basis.



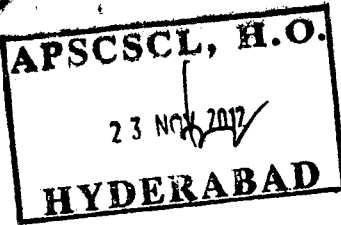



- (i) The State Government will have to furnish a certificate from AG of the State or the Local Fund Audit Department of Agricultural Produce Marketing Committees if their accounts are audited by them to the effect that the amount collected by way of market fee has actually been utilized for the purpose of development of mandis.
- (ii) Differential Sales tax may be considered by FCI if admissible as per State Act.
- (iii) RD Cess will be allowed subject to certification by the Accountant General of the State that the amount collected by way of RD Cess has actually been utilized for the purpose for which it has been collected.
- (iv) The administrative charges are payable to State Govt. subject to recovery adjustment of State Administrative Surcharges (SAS) paid by FCI to State Govt. during the period.

4. As per para 4 of this Department's letter No.192(4)/2003-FC.A/Cs. dated.16th July, 2003, the rate/cost of Custom Milled Rice (CMR) and other elements as indicated above are final. If the State Government feels that there is adequate justification for a revision in a particular component, the claim would be considered on the basis of detailed justification submitted for the increase, alongwith documentary proof and accounts audited by the auditors appointed by the Comptroller and Auditor General.

5. To ensure proper utilization of funds/subsidy being released by the Government of India, the FCI may insist on submission of accounts of the State Government and its agencies before release of incidentals on account of statutory charges i.e. Market Fee, RD Cess etc. as per past practice.

The State Government should submit their proposals for final rates latest within a period of three months after the end of the season as prescribed vide the erstwhile Department of Food & Civil Supplies' Circular letter No.192(20)/95-FC.A/Cs dated 21.8.1997. All other conditions contained therein would also apply.

2. The above rates are final excepting the transportation charges which are provisional and will be paid/reimbursed on actual basis for a distance beyond 8 kms. Only subject to maximum of the rates fixed by the District Magistrate of the concerned area and verification by Food Corporation of India.

3. The cost of new B.Twill gunny bags will be allowed at Rs. 23.13 per bag for 95 kg. bags @ Rs. 18.27 per bag for 75 kg. bags @ Rs. 15.82 per bag for 50 kg. bags.

4. It may be noted that driage is granted for the entire stock though driage, if at all, occurs only during the later part of the season. The State Government should therefore enter into the milling agreement with the millers suitably to ensure that millers do not gain in the initial part of the season for driage.

5. The Custom Milled Rice would be delivered by the procuring agencies to FCI, in 75 kg./50 kg. bags only, in its local godowns upto scale point and the stacking in the FCI godown will be done by FCI.

6. Specifications for procurement of paddy/rice laid down vide the Department's letters No. 8-3/2000-S&I dt. 11-9-2000 and 19-9-2000 shall also be strictly followed."

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
