The Government of India vide the references cited have communicated the final rates of CMR delivered by the Govt. of A.P., and its Agencies to the Central Pool by the State Government for the KMS 2000-01 to 2005-06. The Commissioner of Civil Supplies & EOS, Govt. of A.P., have also directed to submit the final claims to the FCI for payment of the difference amounts.

The GOI have not considered the actual expenditure incurred by the Corporation while finalizing the final rates of CMR delivered to the Central Pool. Therefore, the GOI was requested to reconsider the matter and orders are awaited. The matter has been perceived with the GOI.

In view of the above it has been decided to prefer claims as per the final rates of CMR approved by the GOI subject to revision of the same after receipt of the orders from the GOI.

The GOI approved rates for the KMS 2000-01 to 2005-06 are sent herewith in Annexure I to VI.

The District Managers, CSC, are requested to prepare KMS wise and season wise (Khariff and Rabi) separate claims for these six (6) crop years and submit the same to the respective Area Managers, FCI and obtain payment of the difference amounts.

In addition to the above final rates of CMR differential Sales Tax i.e. the Sales Tax payable as per the final rates of CMR and Purchase Tax of 4% on paddy allowed by the FCI earlier, is also to be claimed along with the final rates of CMR.

The KMS wise differential Sales Tax to be claimed is detailed in the Annexure – VII. The KMS wise / Variety wise, Boiled and Raw rice delivered to FCI as per the final accounts furnished by the District Offices are communicated in the Annexure – VIII for ready reference.

The FCI earlier released the Custody & Maintenance charges, Interest, Gunny Depreciation, Statutory charges i.e. RD Cess and Market Fee as per the Provisional Cost sheet and later recovered those amounts in subsequent bills due to some audit paras and other administrative orders of the FCI. Hence, only the net amount released by the FCI as on date shall be deducted from the amount payable as per the final rates of CMR. Hence, the District Managers, CSC, shall prepare the claims with utmost care, duly taking into consideration of the net amounts received from FCI.

The progress of the claims preferred on Area Managers, FCI, and realization of amounts shall be informed to Head Office on weekly basis.



(i) Guarantee Fee, if it is actually paid by the agencies to the State Government for obtaining credit, would be payable on actual basis, subject to a maximum of 1/8% of MSP worked out on the estimated quantity of paddy delivered to FCI procured under Price Support Scheme (PSS) for the Central Pool. No interest on delayed payment on this account will be payable.

(ii) For transportation of paddy and rice beyond 3 kms, the charges are payable based on rate fixed by the District Collectors of the State or FCI's rate whichever is lower.

- 3. The Custom Milled Rice would be delivered by the procuring agencies to FCI, in 50 kg bags only, in its local godowns upto the scale point and the stacking in the corporate win but uplie by PCI.

- To ensure proper utilization of funds/subsidy being released by the Government of India, the FCI may insiet on requisite and its agencies before release of incidentals on account of statutory charges i.e. Market Fcc, RD Coss etc. as per past practice.



- 2. Final payment of the following statutory charges will be subject to the following conditions:-
- (a) Market Fee: The State Government will have to furnish a certificate from the AG of the State or the Local Fund Audit Department of Agricultural Produce Marketing Committees if their accounts are audited by them to the effect that the amount collected by way of market fee has actually been utilized for the purpose of development of mandis.
- (b) <u>R.D.Cess</u>: This will be allowed subject to certification by the Accountant General of the State that the amount collected by way of R.D. Cess has actually been utilized for the purpose for which it has been collected.
- 3. In addition to the above, the State Government will be reimbursed transportation charges for the distance beyond 8 kms. The lesser of the rates fixed by the FCl and those fixed by the District Collectors within a State will be accepted.
- 4. Guarantee fee will be payable if it is actually paid and would be subject to the maximum of 1/8% of MSP worked out on the estimated quantity of paddy delivered to FCI procured under Price Support Scheme (PSS) for the Central pool. No interest on delayed payment on this account will be payable.
- 5. The cost of new B. Twill gunny bags will be allowed at Rs.19.98 per bag for 50 Kg. bags.
- 6. The Custom Milled Rice would be delivered by the procuring agencies to FCI, in 50 kg bags only or 75 kg bags if specifically allowed by Government of India, in its local godowns upto scale point and the stacking in the FCI godown will be done by FCI.
- 7. The State Government should submit their proposals for final rates latest within a period of three months after the end of the season as prescribed vide the erstwhile Department of Food & Civil Supplies' Circular letter No.192(20)/95-FC.A/Cs dated 21.8.1997. All other conditions contained therein would also apply.

- 2. Final payment of the following statutory charges will be subject to the following conditions:-
- (a) Market Fee: The State Government will have to furnish a certificate from the AG of the State or the Local Fund Audit Department of Agricultural Produce Marketing Committees if their accounts are audited by them to the effect that the amount collected by way of market fee has actually been utilized for the purpose of development of mandis.

- (b) R.D.Cess: This will be allowed subject to certification by the Accountant General of the State that the amount collected by way of R.D. Cess has actually been utilized for the purpose for which it has been collected.
- 3. In addition to the above, the State Government will be reimbursed transportation charges for the distance beyond 8 kms. The lesser of the rates fixed by the FCI and those fixed by the District Collectors within a State will be accepted.
- 4. Guarantee fee will be payable if it is actually paid and would be subject to the maximum of 1/8% of MSP worked out on the estimated quantity of paddy delivered to FCI procured under 'Price Support Scheme (PSS) for the Central pool. No interest on delayed payment on this account will be payable.
 - 5. The cost of new B. Twill gunny bags will be allowed at Rs.21.13 per bag for 50 Kg. bags.
 - 6. Depreciation on gunny bags would be payable @ Rs.28.18 per qtl. when 75 kg. bags are used for paddy (50 kg) and rice delivered in 50 kg. bags.
 - 7. It may be noted that driage is granted for the entire stock though driage, if at all, occurs only during the latter part of the season. The State Government should therefore enter into the milling agreement with the millers suitably to ensure that millers do not gain in the initial part of the season for the driage.
 - 8. The Custom Milled Rice would be delivered by the procuring agencies to FCI, in 50 kg bags only, in its local godowns upto scale point and the stacking in the FCI godown will be done by FCI.
 - 9. The State Government should submit their proposals for final rates latest within a period of three months after the end of the season as prescribed vide the erstwhile Department of Food & Civil Supplies' Circular letter No.192(20)/95-FC.A/Cs dated 21.8.1997. All other conditions contained therein would also apply.
