INTRODUCTION:

The A P State Civil Supplies Corporation Limited (APSCSCL) has invited e-auction for Empanelment of Agency for Packing of Rice in 25kg PP Bags for distribution under MDM and Hostels& 3 kg Pillow Type PP Woven bag with BOPP Lamination& Secondary packing in 50 kg PP Bags for THR under ICDS program throughout the state. APSCSCL shallfollowdistrictwiseonlinee-auctionmodeandhasentrustedthesametoNCDEXe- Markets Ltd. for conducting electronic reverse auction for Packing of Rice at designated godowns with Pre-installed machineries by APSCSCL / Manual Mode by the selected agency.

1. SCOPEOFWORK:

A) Packing of Fine Rice in 25KgPPBags:

The selected Packing Agencies shall be responsible for carrying out the following activities as part of the rice packing operations in line with the instructions issued by APSCSCL from time to time under the supervision of the concerned District Civil Supplies Manager (DCSM).

De-stacking of 50kg bags and packing in 25kg bags& Stacking of packed Rice Stocks in Scientific manner.

- The Fine Quality Rice (FQR) stocks will be issued from the designated procuring Buffer Godown(s) / MLS points of APSCSCL.
- Note: There is no fixed packing location. The location may change from time to time depending on logistical, operational, and space constraints. The packingagency shall remain flexible and responsive to suchchanges.

Handling of Packing Material

- The25KgPPBagsandQRCodeTagSheetswillbesuppliedbyAPSCSCL.
- Thepackingagencyshallensurethesafecustodyandproperutilizationof all packing materials and avoid any misuse or wastage.
- The packing agency shall procure the following items/material on their own:
 - a) QR Code Scanners (as per specifications prescribed by APSCSCL),
 - b) IndustrialStitchingMachines&Weighing scales.
 - Requiredqualitystitchingthreads.

ThepackingagencyshallperformScanning, De-bagging, Packing & Stitching:

- Each 50 Kg jute bag of Fine Quality Rice will have a QR Code (tagged/attached/printed/labelled).
- ThepackingagencyshallscantheQRCodeoneach50Kgbagusingthe approved QR Code Scanners prior to de-bagging.
- Aftersuccessfulscanning, the contents of the 50 Kgjutebagshallbe equally divided and packed into two (2) separate 25 KgPPBags.
- Eachfilled25KgPPBagshallbeproperlystitchedusingindustrial-grade stitching machines.
- Thestitchedbagsmustbetagged/attached/printed/labelledwithanewQR

- Code, ensuring full traceability of origin and movement as per APSCSCL protocol.
- Shall Position sufficient number of Manpower to complete the targeted quantitywellwithinthestipulatedperiodoftime.
- The packing agency shall bear expenditure, if any, for shifting of allocated stocks from one block / compartment to another block / compartment whenever is necessary.
- It is the responsibility of the packing agency to check quality of Rice and infestation before packing. If the agency notices infestation before packing, the agency shall inform concerned DCSM for replacement / re-allocation of stocks.
- Ifanyquality/infestationissuesfoundafterpacking,thepackingagency will be responsible for replacement and re-packing of stocks at their own cost, and penalty will be imposed apart from blacklisting the agency in participation future Govt. tenders for two years.
 Post-PackingHandling&Stacking
- Afterpacking, the 25 Kgbagsshall bestacked in a systematicand traceable manner in the designated godown/block.
- In case of space constraints, the packing agency shall coordinate with the concerned DCSM to shift and stack the packed bags in adjacent blocks/godowns.

PackingQuantityDetermination

- The quantity of rice bags to be packed will be determined based on movement orders issued by the DCSM.
- The packing agency shall strictly adhere to the timelines for packing and deliveryofriceasperthequantitycommunicated.

Records&Returns: Maintain daily registers showing rice received, 25 Kg packets packed and stocks handed over to godown Incharge, and no of empty jute gunnies (of 50 Kgoriginal supply bags) returned to APSCSCLingo odcondition.

If the Government scheme is closed or partly revised or modified, due to any decision of State/Central Government or any amendment and the proceedings of distribution is stopped or revised or modified by the APSCSCL then the agreement/contractwillautomaticallycometoanendorpartlycontinuesforwhich Packing Agency is not entitled to demand/receive any type of loss amount or cannot initiate any legal proceedings against APSCSCL.

B) $\underline{Packing of Rice in 3 KgBOPP Laminated PPB ags (THRScheme under ICDS):}$

The packing agency shall receive rice stocks in 50 Kg jute bags supplied by APSCSCL,unpackthem,andrepackthericeinto3KgBOPPlaminatedPPwovenbags (to be procured by the agency). The packed 3 Kg bags shall be further packed into secondary 50 Kg PP woven bags, with 15 packets in each secondary bag (the secondarybagsshallalsobeprocuredbytheagency). The biddershall quote the

operational cost per quintal for undertaking the above operations for 3 Kgpacking.

- i. ReceiptofRicein50Kgjutebags: Receivericein50Kgjutebags supplied by APSCSCLat the designated packing points and handle stocks safely inside the godown/packing premises.
- ii. Packing into 3 Kg Bags: Unpack rice from 50 Kg jute bags and repack into 3 Kg BOPP laminated PP woven bags.
- iii. Procurementof3Kgbagsshallbedonebythepackingagencyatits owncost,withapproveddesigns/logosasprescribedbyAPSCSCL.Each 3 Kg bag shall be sealed/stitched.
- iv. SecondaryPacking(50Kg):15packetsof3Kgriceshallbe packed into one 50 Kg PP woven sack.
- v. Procurementof50KgsecondaryPPbagsshallalsobedonebythe packing agency. Ensure proper stitching of the secondary bags.
- vi. Stacking :Stack the finished 50 Kg secondary bags properly in a scientific manner.
- vii. Records& Returns:Maintain daily registers showing rice received, 3 Kg packets packed, secondary bags prepared and handed over to godown Incharge, and no of empty jute gunnies (of 50 Kg original supplybags)returnedtoAPSCSCLingoodcondition.

In order to facilitate Agency or Packers to participate in NCDEX_e-Markets Limited process, registration with NCDEX e-Markets Ltd. is mandatory.

2. ELIGIBILITY/PREQUALIFICATIONCONDITIONS.

- viii. Any Tenderer whose contract with the APSCSCL or any other Govt./Private organization has been terminated for violation of termsandconditionsofthecontractbeforetheexpiryofthecontractperiodat any point of time during last two years, will be ineligible.

- iii. Registered Participants whose Technical bids are qualified, are eligible to participate in electronic bidding system (e-auction) for packing of Rice conducted by NCDEX e-MARKETS LTD as and when scheduled.

- ii. Thetechnically qualified tenderers are eligible to participate in e-auction.
- iii. The Corporation organizes the e-reverse auction based on the L1 rate received in the tender.
- iv. Any changes made in the time schedule will be intimated to all the participants by publishing the same in the websites of APSCSCL and NCDEX eMARKETSLTD website.
- v. The tenderer shall take adequate care and is solely responsible to obtain details of the schedule of e-Auction through the websites in their own interest, rather thandependingonothermode of information sources.
- vi. The bidder can modify his bid as many number of times as possible till the closing time of e-auction subject to overall reduction in the price. The systemtimeof NCDEXeMARKETSLTDplatformwillbeconsideredtostart and end the e-auction.

- xiv. The price bid for providing rates shall be quoted in Indian Rupees per Quintal. Therateshall bequoted for all the slabs. The L1 bid der will be finalized basing on the weighted average rate quoted for corresponding quantities on the least cost basis. Failure to quote for a Group will result in the rejection of the bid by the online electronic platform.
